Modern day Rap music is a primary ingredient of Hip-Hop music and culture. The origins of Rap can be traced back to the West African griot tradition. Griots were an important part of the culture and social life of the village. Griots told and retold the historical narratives and oral traditions of their people, keeping their stories and traditions alive. The Griots may use their vocal expertise for gossip, satire and political commentary. They focused on bringing families together and providing positive narratives in difficult times and times of turmoil and pain.

The evolution of Rap music has not been positive. Some Rappers today write and perform songs that graphically describe violence, substance abuse, misogyny and materialism to excessive measures. They are characterizing a factually ugly and dysfunctional condition of life. Remember, rap is an artistic depiction of real life in American cities and ghettoes. These geographic locations are characterized by limited educational availabilities, poverty and the ubiquitous systemic racism.

While all of this is true, it is equally true that some of today's Rap music reflects a Black American culture that is negative in nature. It is the very same false and negative perception of Black American culture that the dominant White

culture has been attempting to assign to us for centuries: a violent, misogynistic, uncaring, inhuman and negative culture. This perception is an urban myth and regrettably some Rappers are assisting in reenforcing this big lie.

The glorification of these Rappers by giving them awards of merit is a huge mistake, unless you desire to perpetuate the myth of the negative Black American culture. -Al Martin
